## About UCAC

Since 1970, the **Utility Contractors Association of Connecticut** has represented contractors, suppliers and vendors in the utility and site work construction industry in Connecticut. UCAC contractor members perform work to improve and enhance the utility infrastructure in the state, which includes drainage systems, sanitary and stormwater sewers, gas and water lines, boring, cables, ducts, conduits, tunneling and trenchless technology.

## Member Benefits

### Advocacy

UCAC lobbies for policies that improve utility contracting and construction, including:

- Clean Water Fund
- Underground Damage Prevention Program
- Infrastructure funding and capital improvement projects.

UCAC opposes unnecessary barriers to construction and development in the state and participates in industry coalitions such as the Clean Water Investment Coalition. UCAC also works closely with government agencies, such as PURA, and officials in its Gas Pipeline Safety Unit.



### Safety

UCAC members protect the public safety by avoiding damage to underground facilities and maintaining a safe construction site. UCAC participates in Call Before You Dig and offers safety and education training programs for members.

### Resources

From *In the Pipeline*, a periodic newsletter to members, and its website, [www.ucac.pro](http://www.ucac.pro), to legislative alerts, UCAC keeps members informed about news and information relevant to the industry.

### Networking and events

UCAC sponsors important and timely programs and events on topics relevant to the industry, providing opportunities for members to receive education and network with government officials and industry colleagues.

### Scholarship program

UCAC awards scholarships to eligible children of members who are graduating high school and attending college in the fall. The program is supported through an annual auction and generous contributions; award recipients and families are honored with a special dinner.

### NUCA

UCAC serves as a chapter of the National Utility Contractors Association, which provides opportunities to participate at the national level.
