

UCAC Scholarship FAQs

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any senior high school student who is a son, daughter, or stepchild of a Utility Contractors Association of Connecticut, Inc. Member or of an Employee of a Member (in good standing – up to date with UCAC payments) and who will be enrolling full-time in an academic institution for the year beginning in September. This may be a four-year college or community college. (Grandchildren of UCAC members or employee members are not eligible.)

HOW WILL APPLICATIONS BE JUDGED? Selection will be based on the overall worthiness of the applicant. The Scholarship Committee will consider 1) academic standing, 2) ACT and/or SAT scores, 3) extracurricular activities, 4) career goals, 5) employment experience, 6) essay, and 7) thoroughness of the completed application.

HOW WILL THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE APPLICATION BE PROTECTED? When the application is received by UCAC, each application will be numbered and an acknowledgement of receipt will be sent to the applicant. Page 1 of the application will be placed in a sealed envelope marked with the number of the application. The Scholarship Committee will review the applications (with no knowledge of the name, address, etc. of the applicant). When selection(s) have been made, only the winning envelope(s) will be opened and only award recipient(s) will be notified. The remaining envelopes will be destroyed.

HOW DO I APPLY? Complete an application, which can be found on the UCAC website under “Scholarships.”

WHEN MUST I APPLY? All applications must be submitted no later than 5 pm on Wednesday, May 23, 2018. The award winner(s) will be notified in June and should plan to attend the Scholarship Awards Dinner in July.
